Thank you for your letter of the 13th and for your apology, which I readily accept. May I assume that you have sent a copy of your letter to me to the editors of MIDNIGHT?

Thank you also for the several articles which you enclosed and which I read with interest. Contrary to your prediction, the articles did not displease me. Rather, I am in agreement with many of your arguments—that Oswald was a patsy who never fired a shot at JFK (or anyone else); that the attempt to incriminate Fidel Castro is without basis in fact or logic; and that the role of the New York Times, the Washington Post, and (I would add) CBS, among other major news media, in continuing to hawk the debased and discredited Warren Report tells a terrifying and sinister story about the corruption of the American press and its betrayal of its mission. I congratulate you on your outspoken attack on the forces behind the assassination and its cover-up and I look forward to seeing your book published. I hope that you will find it possible to have a review copy sent to me.
