Thanks for your memorandum of 27 May 1977 and your recent correspondence with the House Select Committee. I have always regarded the medical and autopsy evidence as the key to the case and I am glad that attention is being paid by the Committee to that area. I can only suggest that the Committee should give the most serious study to the published critiques by responsible critics, including of course your own work. In particular, I would call attention to what appears to be, <u>prima facie</u>, a stunning document, reproduced by Harold Weisberg on page 266 of his book POST MORTEM—that is, a receipt for "a missile removed by Commander James J. Humes" on 22 November 1963.
