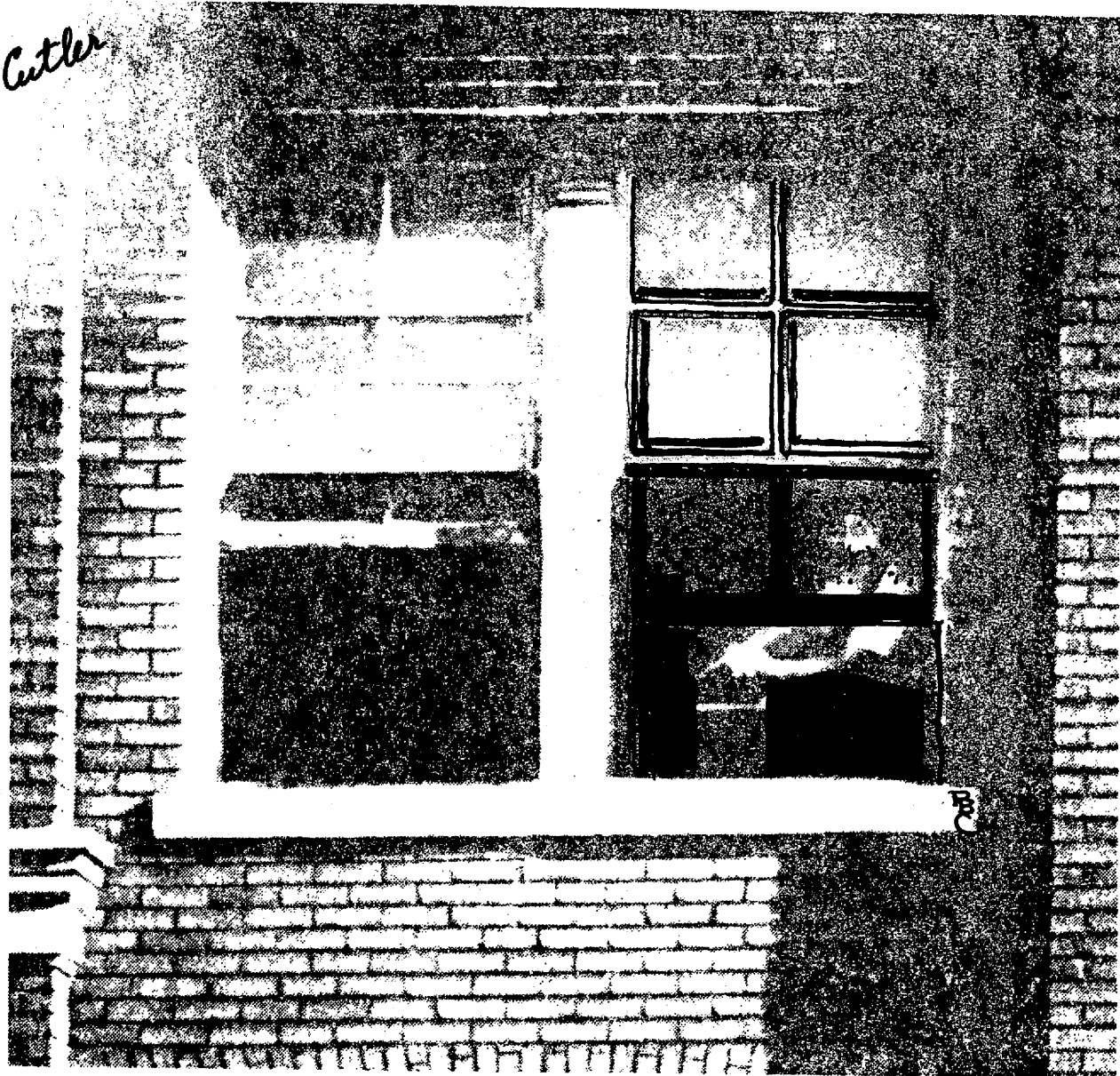


Bob Cutler



This UPI photo on page one of the Boston Globe, VIII/21/78, was captioned: "A police sharpshooter firing at sandbags from a sixth-floor window of the Texas School Book Depository building as part of a test to determine how many shots were fired at President Kennedy."

This retouched copy displays an "instant replay" of Oswald's alleged assassination of the President from this window, the Warren Report's designate. The dirty panes of the properly positioned lower sash block the sharpshooter's view of almost everything. The pile of "gun-rest boxes" and those seen and unseen forming the "inner barricade" hinder the sharpshooter's proper positioning of his body to track, aim and fire at a moving target, if he could see it. The lefthand window was closed that day.

The sharpshooter's devastatingly simple opening of the "assassin's window" in 1978 in order to first see, then aim and fire at the sandbag target is the best evidence of conspiracy ever placed on the public record of this murder. It exposes not only the physical impossibility of accurately shooting to kill from this encumbered lair but also the continuing coverup of this monstrous fabrication by the federal government.

The House Select Committee on Assassinations, its expert engineers, the Dallas Police, UPI and the Boston Globe will always be remembered for succeeding in proving the innocence of Lee Harvey Oswald without even trying.
