A very good friend of mine with whom I cooperate on matters related to the JFK assassination, Roger Feinman, is engaged in litigation with CBS. Roger has been acting as his own lawyer (he is a second-year law student) but has reached a stage where he needs professional legal advice. His suit is related to the JFK assassination and the Warren Report--that is, he was employed by CBS News (TV) and persistently raised questions about the several CBS "documentaries" in which CBS sought to sell the Warren Report to the public and to denigrate and dismiss important evidence of conspiracy. For his pains, Roger was dismissed, on a pretext, and his union failed completely to protect his interests. His case is now nearing trial.

I have taken the liberty of giving Roger your office number and have suggested that he telephone you later this week. I will be most grateful to you for any help you feel able to give Roger.
