Do you remember that back in '64 a rumor was floating around that one Darrell (or Daryl) Click was somehow involved in the Kennedy assassination? He was spoken of as a taxi cab driver, and someone "found" a small, private cab company in Dallas for which he was said to have worked. Well, it turned out that the private cab company didn't exist, and that little bubble burst. Eventually the name "Darrell Click" faded out too. Wm. Whaley & Scoggins remained the only cab drivers connected with the Nov. 22 events. The "Click" name was said to come from a news report on TV or Radio, and it was suggested that the words "Duck Cliff" led to the confusion. The matter was never resolved.

Last Sunday (Feb 14) as I read an article in the NY Times Magazine section by Paul Hofmann entitled "The Jesuits, Portrait of a Troubled Order," I came across the name "Daryl Glick" and the similarity rang a bell for me. Of course the likelihood of coincidence is high and I don't claim it means anything. BUT I do think that the possibility is worth the tiny amount of mind-space and file-space it takes up.

Hofmann was telling of the Opus Dei headquarters in Rome, its General Council in which 80 different nationalities are represented, and reported that "The organization's 4,000 members in the U.S. are represented in Rome by David Sperling and Daryl Glick, who constantly shuttle between Rome and their organizations here."

And I recall that John Foster Dulles' son is a Jesuit as influential one. He used to live in Dallas, or one of the Texas' cities. A number of persons closely connected with the ass-
assination "investigations" or cover-up are Catholic: Blakley, E. Howard Hunt, James Jesus Angleton, Wm. Colby (I think), McLane, probably most of the Cubans, I don't know about John Connally. I'm not anti-Catholic, but the Vatican was anti-President Kennedy.

Also I've never forgotten pp. 364-365 (re Vatican) of James Kirkwood's American Grotesque. I don't buy it just as expressed but I do believe there's something important there and that this matter probably explains why Clay Shaw's mysterious death. Assassination matters just go on and on and on. However, the Dreyfus case took 12 years, and the JFK etc. cases are much bigger. Meanwhile there are constant gains in information and understanding, and Toozzi and others showed up the Blakley so-called investigation. I think in the end the truth will win out.
