

A general bibliography and collection of literature by and about Robert F. Kennedy scrutinizes his years as Attorney General, senator, and presidential candidate. Cited works on Senator Edward Kennedy include general bibliographies, works on his years as a senator, and books and articles on his ill-fated 1980 presidential campaign. All writings appear in chronological order.

An important contribution to our ability to investigate and understand the Kennedy family's impact on modern American history and politics, this bibliography also provides a key to personal insights into the lives of the Kennedys—their writings, their ancestry, their marriages, and their individual political careers. Any reader who is intrigued by the major impact of this exceptional family will appreciate this comprehensive volume.
