

PRICE of your books appears in the righthand column. The microfilm price (MIC\$) appears first. The paperbound reprint price (XER\$) appears in the last column and is the highest price. Cloth bindings are \$5.00 more per volume. Prices listed are U.S. and Canadian. Please add 15% for delivery to the rest of the world. Shipping and handling charges are additional. Pre-payment is required from individuals. All books are sold on a nonreturnable basis.

The spelling of AUTHOR and TITLE is abbreviated because information about each book has been limited to one line. Please be assured that the complete author and title entry appears in all promotions.

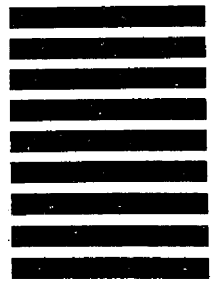

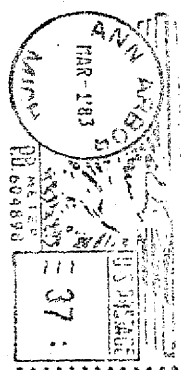
