Dear Paul,

It was good to talk to you last night. I have now finished Hart's book and continue to think that what is good--and there is much that is good--is virtually nullified by the Easterling chapter. It will be interesting to see the reviews when they come out.

I have also quickly scanned the material on LEGEND which you were good enough to send me and for which I am grateful. Isn't it curious that both Francis Gary U-2 Powers and George de Mohrenschildt died unnatural deaths just before their appointments with Epstein? Does he have the kiss of death, or is he merely corrupt, venal, and despicable?

On page 11 of your Rough Notes on the secret world of EJB, dated 6 April 1978, item (31), you say "Lots of useful comments from David Liften, Sylvia, Harold, Brad Sparks, Russ Stetler, Mary, Jim Kostman, and others." I would very much like to have copies of that material. Is that feasible? If not, could I have copies of my own letters or comments in whatever form they were made? I think all or most of this material was included in my lost file on Legend.

Even now, more than 22 years after the assassination, I still get occasional phonecalls from young people looking for copies of the Subject Index or just wishing to talk about the case. Some of these people seem extremely bright and thoroughly serious. The case will never die.
