About the "model kit" -- you no doubt have reference to the "Jackdaw Special" kit on The Assassination of President Kennedy, compiled and designed by Michael Rand, Howard Loxton and Len Deighton, Jackdaw Publications, founded and distributed by Jonathan Cape, 30 Bedford Square, London, England, copyright 1967. It is a stiff folder with loose "fact sheets" inside and a cardboard three-dimensional scale model of Dealey Plaza. I do not know if it is still available or what the price is, although as I recall it was under \$5.00.

Lifton's Document Addendum did cost at least \$17.50 as I recall it.

I know very little about Skolnick and have a poor opinion of his work, so far as I am acquainted with it.
