Dear Mrs Meagher

doesn't want to sell me "Autopsy". Perhaps it is not finished.
Here is your revised entry. I hope Ann Arbor sends me

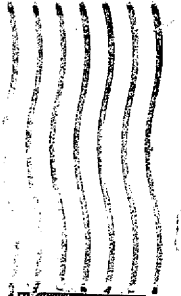
