Dear Mrs. Abzug:

Thank you for your letter of November 17, in behalf of Ms Sylvia Meagher of New York, who was concerned that her complaint of September 7, 1971, resulted in the dismissal of Mr. Patrick A. Agresti, a letter carrier assigned to the Village Station in New York.

I have been informed that Mr. Agresti received a letter of charges for unsatisfactory performance, on July 10, 1971, indicating that he was to be suspended for a period of seven days. This seven day suspension is now held in abeyance pending the outcome of Mr. Agresti's appeal to the New York Regional Postmaster General.

Thus, no action was taken to permanently separate Mr. Agresti, and this disciplinary suspension action occurred before Ms Meagher lodged her complaint.
