Thanks for sending the clippings...as a matter of fact, there were a couple of interesting bits...For example, the full-page story in the Dallas Times-Herald names Lillian Rogers as Zapruder's secretary (who persuaded him to watch and film the motorcade)...but a document in the Hearings and Exhibits, a report by a deputy sheriff on 11/22/63, names the same secretary as Marilyn Sitzman of 202 S. Lancaster.

If you are inclined to make some discreet inquiries, I would be quite interested to know who is Zapruder's secretary now, and who it was on 11/22/63. Marilyn Sitzman is not listed in the 1964 Dallas phonebook; but there is one (Mrs) Lillian Rogers at 1096 West Davis St, Wh 8-9690. Think of an ingenious reason to phone, maybe, soliciting a contribution or something, and maybe find out what is up.

You didn't write anything about yourself. Is everything status quo ante?? My nose is still at the grindstone, doing last-minute corrections and additions to the index so as not to delay page-proofs; did an all-night broadcast, as I think I told you already, with Sylvan Fox among others; trying to light a fire under the people who are supposed to do something with my idea for dramatic readings; and hoping to get back to my book before I fold up from age and depletion. Do write whenever you feel in the mood.
