Dear Mr Waldo,

I have studied your testimony in the Hearings and Exhibits of the Warren Commission with considerable interest and it seems to me that either Mark Lane or Jones Harris mentioned not long ago that you are working on a book dealing with the assassination. It occurs to me, therefore, that you may find some interest in the enclosed copies of letters I have sent which have remained unanswered or without satisfactory reply. Please regard this correspondence as confidential and solely for your personal information.

I am also at work on a book, a comparative study of the conflicts between the assertions in the Warren Report, on the one hand, and the Hearings and Exhibits, on the other. My subject index to the Report and the Hearings and Exhibits (together with a name index covering some of the Exhibits) will be published early next year by Scarecrow Press. I mention that not to drum up sales but in case such an index may be useful to you in your own work on the case. Perhaps I should also mention, at the risk of carrying coals to Newcastle, that quite arresting articles and editorials on the Warren Report are appearing in the Midloshian Mirror (Texas).
