(1) On the "Palce Oswalds"

(a) Manager & staff of the "Joe & Howard" motel in Zurich. In March 1964 "The Realist" reported that in September 1963 a man signed in there as "Joe Oswald, Dallas" & that the relevant page of the register had been removed by the FBI.

(b) James F. Kigwitz (alias

Joseph Sandberg & Stephen J. Sanders) on November 23

1963 as told the New York

FBI HQ - L. 0 1 1

Oswald in 1962 in Greenwald Village. Eventually he was arraigned for firing false information (N.Y. Times Dec 6 1963)

(2) On the arrest of a person suspect, unnamed, later after the assassination

(a) George S. Carter, reporter on the "Dallas Times Herald" who originally wrote the story mentioning the second arrest.

(b) Baltimore W. E. Barker, who made the arrest according to this account.

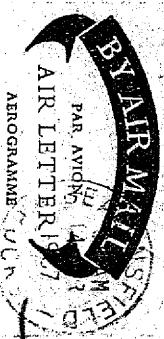
