The Scarecrow Press has forwarded your letter to me. I am sorry to tell you that my Subject Index (which had sold for \$4.00) is out of print. The publishers do not contemplate issuing a second edition. In any event, the Subject Index is useful only if one owns or has access to the 26 volumes of Hearings and Exhibits. It is not narrative or prose but literally a series of listings of volumes, pages, and document numbers.

Thank you for your comments on my article in Esquire, which was only a sample, not a comprehensive survey. In fact, the original manuscript I submitted included the name of David Ferris --I imagine the magazine was sorry that it had deleted Ferris and several other names of witnesses not called.

I appreciate the information you sent about the other witnesses you described in your letter. Please excuse me for addressing you by your name, but it was not clear whether I should say "Miss" or "Mr."
