Dear Mrs. Meagher :

I have just returned to Canada from a brief visit to New Orleans and Dallas where in my talks with a number of persons I gained a generally favourable impression of the Garrison probe.

I still have doubts, however, concerning the true identity of the "Leon" Oswald who attended the alleged Ferrie apartment meeting. Mrs. J.J. Garner, Oswald's former landlady, and a number of other persons who met Oswald in New Orleans can never recall having seen Oswald in an unshaven condition and told me that they find it difficult to accept Russo's description as a portrait of the real Lee Harvey Oswald.

In talking with James Altgens in Dallas , I learned that a man from New York visited Dallas over a year ago and showed Mr. Altgens a photograph of a man leaning over the wooden fence pointing what seemed to be a rifle at the Presidential limousine . Apparently this was not the Nix film . Mr. Altgens was told the photo would be released in due course but has heard nothing since .

I would be most grateful for any information you might have come across concerning this mysterious photo . I would be very interested also in your assessment of the latest findings by Vincent Salandria and others concerning the Tippit affair .
