I shouldn't take more than a month to answer a letter but the timing of the answer was not urgent and I was busy finishing up the last details of my MS while trying at the same time to do, always, one last bit of research. Of course, as you know, it can't be done. I just had to cut off and declare the MS to be finished though, of course, it is anything but. The loose ends of evidence in this case are probably bigger in bulk than the evidence—I mean the publicly available evidence—itself. But that, of course, is inevitable in a falsified record.

In any event my book will be published by Arlington House, the people who run the Conservative Book Club, but they plan also to seek book store sales. The title will be The Murder of the President with a subtitle A Look at the Hard Evidence. Publication date will be late December or early January. I hope to get a little advance attention to it for two reasons: First, I would like it to get attention and sell well; Second, So far as I know there is no other technically thorough examination, and if I may say so, technically sound destruction of the so-called hard evidence, and I would like to see these unarguable facts thrown into the public discussion. The defenders of the Commission will, I think, have nothing to do but ignore the book, which I suspect they will do, voluminously.

I suppose you know that your invaluable *Index* occupies the position of unofficial volume 27 of the Warren Commission record on the shelves of the Archives. It carries a list of errata in the back in which I should have but lacked the time to check the few errors I noted. Just in case they are not yet noted here are the few I have noticed:

p 24 line 8 from bottom, Revill is the wrong name. It should be Brian.

p 137 line 16, Stringer. The line reads, "CE 2033 (p242) 2433" It should read, "CE 2003 (p 242, 243)"

p 140, between Wright, L.R. and Wulf there is a name missing: Wright, O.P. CE1024, 18-799 [To be sure this is an internal name and you don't usually index them, but he is chsequential.]
