Dear Sylvia :

I am enclosing a clipping from the November edition of Maclean's Magazine re the Garrison inquiry .

I personally remain very much in a quandary concerning the New Orleans investigation .

There are indeed some disturbing aspects to the Garrison inquiry - not the least of which are statements such as Garrison's letter appearing in the November issue of The Minority of One .

On the other hand , I still feel Garrison is almost certainly on the right track and might yet furnish the evidence he has promised .

In fairness to Garrison , it should be noted also that even Judge Haggerty has attributed the use of delaying tactics in the Shaw case to the attorneys representing Shaw rather than to the District Attorney's office .

In any event the Shaw trial should help to clear the air and I look forward to visiting New Orleans at the time of the trial in February .

I was most interested in the Post excerpt from Professor Josiah Thompson's book . He presents his case in a very convincing manner . I have both his work and yours on order and look forward very much to reading both books .
