I have been trying to obtain an
used copy of your book "Subject Index to the
Warren Report, and Hearings and Exhibits"
for about a year, with no success.

It has been out of print since early 1967.

I wrote the Book of the month club to try
and ^{get} me a copy and they replied, on Mar 27-68
in accessories after the fact is the correct
title of the book you described as "Subject
Index to the Hearings of the Warren
Commission"

Mrs Dorothy Hurst, formerly with the
Spencer Book Co. has written me that she is
also trying to obtain a copy.

Can I obtain your permission to
make 2 electro-static copies of "Subject
Index to the Warren Report and Hearings
and Exhibits" or will I have to take the
enquiry up with Scarecrow Press?

On receipt of your letter of November 28th,
1967 I placed an order for "Accessories
After the Fact:" and received one of the
just copies.

I consider that it is the most complete and
detailed work that I have read and that it
covers the subject more completely than any
other one book.

I have been able to buy or read 65
different books; and have considerable data
on 18 other books that are directly relevant
to the assassination of President John F
Kennedy, that are printed in English.

These are different titles. Different editions
of the same title are not counted - e.g. I have
5 of the different editions of "Red Roses
from Texas." (I have not been able to buy a
copy of the Australian edition which is now
current) and I have all 6 of the different
editions of "The Report of the President's
Commission on the Assassination of President
John F Kennedy" in English.

The only one that really eludes me is "Legacy
of an Assassination" by Norbert Murray. It
seems to be banned - barred and blacklisted.

The titles that I refer to do not include
those that are not directly relevant to the
assassination like books on cartoons,
sermons, poems, plays, biographies etc.

I wrote the Library of Congress for a full
set of Catalogue Cards of their Subject
Heading - Kennedy, John Fitzgerald,
1917-1963 - Assassination and received 72
Cards

36 of these are titles of books that are
directly relevant to the assassination

The other 36 are of gramophone records,
films, transcripts of broadcasts and books
in foreign language that ^{are} directly related to
the assassinations; and also some that are
different editions of the same title

By stretching the imagination "Children
and the Death of a President" and "The Kennedy
Assassination and the American Public" could
be considered to be indirectly connected but
I fail to see where LCC no. R67-448 -

Tartini, Giuseppe, 1692-1770, Phonodisc.
Violin Concerto in D major. has anything
at all that even remotely concerning the
assassination
