Dear Mr. Sherrill,

I think you will share the sorrow many of us feel at the news, soon to be made public, I believe, that The Minority of One has been forced by financial difficulties to discontinue publication. It is a special blow to me, because TMO published many of my articles and book reviews on the Warren Report and related subjects during the last three years. One such book review/essay was to appear in the December issue, but TMO will not publish again.

If I presume on our very slight acquaintance by sending you the ms. of that review, it is because I believe it important that the public should know of the existence of the documents which have been published in the work which occasioned the review. These transcripts of the Warren Commission's executive sessions have clear historical importance; but as yet, they are known only to a small group of critics and researchers.

Do you think The New Republic might be willing to publish this review? If not, can you suggest any other magazine?

I will be grateful for your advice, but will understand if you do not have the time to spare for this matter.
