Dear Mr. McCreight:

The 132 pages of FBI documents which you sent to me on May 24 included material from the Headquarters file entitled "FBI Transmitted to Residents of Russia" which related to Lee Harvey Oswald. Your cover letter specified that the New York office could not locate any references to Oswald in this file which had not previously been sent to or from FBI Headquarters.

However, one of the documents you sent me (serial 100-353496-715) refers to a letter which was apparently not sent to FBIHQ, and to a second letter which was sent to FBIHQ but which was apparently not processed as part of this release.

Specifically, the document you sent me gives as references

"New York letter to Dallas, 3/9/60" and

"New York letter to Bureau, 2/26/60."

I would like a copy of each of these items at your earliest convenience. You might also want to find out why the first item was (apparently) left out of the indexes consulted by the New York office, and why the second item was (apparently) not included in the HQ file which was processed in response to my request.

I understand that these documents may relate to a sensitive source, but I doubt that the information is so sensitive that no part of the documents can be released.
