Thank you very much for the enclosed material, and please forgive me for not returning it sooner. You also will find enclosed the Stanford press release on Liebel's talk.

I have a complete transcript from WNEW-TV of the 3-hour TV show scheduled to run this Saturday. If you do not have a copy and want it, let me know. I note in the transcript that there will be a later program on which people from the Commission or Commission staff will defend the report; it didn't say who.

My idea in wanting to take a look at your manuscript was that, should it be rejected by Bobbs-Merrill for the same reasons given by the editor at Random House, these objections might be taken care of by some editing—without, of course, lessening the book's argument—before you submit it to a third publisher.

Again, thank you for loaning me the material and putting me on your mailing list. I'm enclosing a personal check to take care of any future mailing costs—that's easier for me than stamped envelopes.
