## NOTICE OF HEARING

As you were informed in a prior letter, an investigation has been conducted of you under Executive Order No. 10422, as amended in connection with your employment, with the World Health Organization in New York, New York. This investigation disclosed information which the International Organizations Employees Loyalty Board believes you should have a further opportunity to explain or refute. Accordingly, a hearing has been scheduled in your case.

You are requested to appear personally at the time and place indicated above. You may be represented at the hearing by counsel or a representative of your own choosing, and, in addition to testifying in your own behalf, you may present evidence through witnesses or by affidavit.

If the scheduled place or date of hearing is inconvenient for you and you will communicate the circumstances immediately to the Executive Secretary of the Board, the Board will consider changing the date or place of hearing to more nearly accommodate your convenience and that of the Government. Hearings are regularly held in New York and in Washington, D.C., but may be held elsewhere if, in the opinion of the Board, the circumstances require it. It would be appreciated if you would advise the Executive Secretary of the Board promptly whether you will appear at the hearing.

For your information, there is attached a copy of the regulations of the International Organizations Employees Loyalty Board.
