The United States Resident Delegation to International Organizations in Geneva, Switzerland, has requested that we forward to you the enclosed envelope. At the United Nations Headquarters, the fingerprinting is supervised by Mr. James Harrigan, who is located in Room 787 of the United Nations Secretariat building. If it is desired that the fingerprinting be done at the United States Mission, it is requested that a prior phone call be made either to Mr. Robert Davis of the Mission, or myself. The information called for on the fingerprint chart should be typed in before the fingerprinting is done since the chart will not be returned to you after the fingerprinting is completed.
