Bob wanted to pin down the testimony identifying the two large bullet fragments as having been fired from the C2766 rifle...He was under the impression that the experts had differed but I pointed out that both Frazier and Nicol had identified the fragments, being uncertain only about whether they came from a single bullet or from two different bullets. I referred him to Sauvage's book on the question of whether fragments are sufficient for identification of a weapon, on which Sauvage had quoted Sodermann's textbook "Modern Criminal Investigation."

During the conversation, Bob mentioned that CBS had film taken at the Beckley St. boarding house a few days after 11/22/63, in which the Johnsons are seen hanging draperies and/or blinds on the windows of the room LHO had occupied.

He said also that the script had been revised (and would continue to be altered up to actual broadcast time) but that I would not be very happy with the changes or the net result.

Suggested that I should write to Gould pointing out in advance the kinds of arguments that the CBS documentary should answer but probably would fail to confront.
