Dear Mrs. Meagher:

Many thanks for your thoughtful letter of February 6. I had anticipated that you would be interested in my review, and that you would probably find parts of it unacceptable. On the whole, it seems to me that your criticism of the Warren Commission should more properly be directed specifically at Earl Warren than at the Commission as a whole, though I am not sure it would be of much importance to the case to make this distinction.

Your observation about the absence of reference to Mr. Weisberg in Jim Garrison's foreword to his book reinforces a feeling I had that, on this evidence at least, the relation between the two men seems somewhat unclear. I was not aware of the links between Garrison and Mark Lane, or that Vincent Salandria and Ray Marcus have appeared publicly in support of his position.

I shall look forward with interest to your continuing work on the problem.
