

Excerpts from Ken Goodall's notes on the Theater for Ideas debate

Liebeler No hard facts to disprove the single-missile theory. The bullet didn't hit anything or anywhere else. The line is straight from window to Kennedy to Connally. It is possible that it was shot earlier, while the limousine was partly obscured, possibly fired through tree, so it is possible for lone assassin even if single bullet is not valid.

Griffin FBI is mistaken: "we found so many mistakes in the FBI reports."

Liebeler The Sibert-O'Neill report is not accurate...(replying to Meagher on failure to do neutron activation analysis) It wasn't used because we thought we had adequate evidence....The Warren Report is wrong in saying "All the evidence shows..." "Mr. Frazier is not the brightest man in the world." The evidence of Oswald's presence at the window is the weakest part of the whole thing. "Wishy-washy performance of Mr. Brennan."

Griffin Eyewitness identification not very strong.

Liebeler Erroneous statement in Report, on ammunition being manufactured currently--due to person who wrote it up not reading the sources carefully. "There are many other mistakes like this in the Report." "in the rush to get the Report done" "I can go through the Report and find all sorts of little errors like this."

(Re: autopsy photos) The Commission should have looked at them. But for some reason the Chief Justice didn't want to see them.

Very serious mistakes in these books, particularly Lue and Epstein. The thing that has shaken me more than anything else is the Bickel article. Going through all 26 volumes and evidence, writing a book that will set forth all the evidence on both sides. Report only sets forth evidence that supports the conclusion.
