Thank you for your kind letter and your encouraging words about the work done by critics of the Warren Report.

About the number of the car reported by Mrs. Earlene Roberts: Mrs. Roberts was not certain about the number but when she testified in April 1964 her best recollection was that it was 106 or 107. When she was asked about an FBI report indicating that she had told the FBI on November 29, 1963 that the number of the car was "207," she seemed to suggest that the "207" was a mistake, and reiterated that the number was 107. You will find that testimony in Volume VI, pages 443-444. The matter is discussed in the Warren Report on page 253 (Government Printing Office edition).

I think you may have misunderstood Mr. McKinney about the speed of the Zapruder film. It was 18.3 frames per second, as indicated on page 97 of the Warren Report.

I hope this information is helpful to you.
