Dear Miss Meagher:

Have read with interest about your investigation of the Warren Report-Lee Harvey Oswald situation, and wanted to contact you because my associates and I are producing a motion picture titled "The Trial of Lee Harvey Oswald". This will be a dramatization of the trial that would have been if Oswald had lived.


Our film will present the case for the prosecution and for the defense. To the utmost of our abilities, we will portray both sides as fairly and accurately as possible.

Testimony will be limited to two classifications of statements: those published in the Commission's 26 volumes; and those given directly to us by witnesses not included by the Commission.

From what we have read, I'm sure you could be helpful in adding to the research we have already done on this subject. While we will not be able to pay for research assistance, you would receive screen credit as an important source of the material presented in our film -- if we used your material.
