Billy Sol Estes Case

Henry Marshall 6/3/61 found dead,  
pronounced suicide, no autopsy

Dr John Dunn bought Recos  
Indep. to expose Estes. Oscar  
Giffin was editor. 2/12/62 began  
printing denestling exposé  
Estes tied in to Senator Yarborough

LBS, Estes → jail -  
McClellan purchased full interest but  
killed it. John Dunn was destroyed  
in tangles - up charges, had to  
leave Recos

LBJ suggests denied any ~~link~~  
link to BS Estes

Mary Kimbrough Jones of Agric Dept  
accused Dept of helping Estes -  
was imprisoned - committed  
to mental hospital. Senator  
John Williams of Delaware  
exposed what had been  
done to M K Jones & got her release

Claims Jim W also RR  
& mental inst.

5/18/62 Henry Marshall  
Whitman - "suicide" has  
5 bullets for hand operated  
.22 bolt rifle, carbon monoxide  
in bags, & blow as hand.

Abrams case of murder but  
Jury "unable to agree" if  
"Murder or suicide."

4/4/62 body of Gje Krutilek  
in car whose exhaust found  
near Clint. He was CPA, had  
been gun by FBI day after  
arrest of B. Estes. He had  
worked for "Haley" as to  
what did CPA know that  
warranted his murder? Was  
never seen again after FBI gun  
until decomposing body  
found.

Harold Orr, sentenced - Estes,  
2/28/64 found dead garage -  
exhaust # "accidental carbon monoxide"

Harold Pratt, another employee  
of Estes, also found dead  
in his car of carbon monoxide

July 1960 Dem. Convention  
after JFK on 1st vote. LBJ  
and Rayburn demanded 2nd  
floor - RFK astonished -  
JFK stalled, LBJ said he  
would fight for nomination  
he had earned it & intended to  
get it
