Dear Mrs. Meagher :

Thank you for your letter of February 11th .

I am distressed and much embarrassed to learn that your honorarium has not been forwarded by the Alma Mater Society by this late date .

I am no longer at the University as I am devoting my full time at present to studying the Kennedy assassination question and , unfortunately , some confusion has resulted from the changeover in my department in the middle of the academic year .

I accept complete responsibility for this as I should have made certain that the procedures followed while I was in office were still being followed .

I have phoned the accounting office and have been assured that this matter will be cleared up as soon as bureaucratically possible . To be certain that this matter is dealt with quickly I have made out a personal requisition and will relay a cheque to you by air mail .
