About the mysterious package, you will find in CE 1799 the following information from the Postal Inspection Service ('Arry 'Olmes, sans doute):

On November 25, it was determined that a postage due parcel had been on hand in the Irving post office for Mrs. or Mr. Oswald earlier in the week of the assassination and was delivered about November 20 or 21.

You will find another reference to Wesley Frazier's rifle in CE 2003 (Volume XXIII page 293), in a report by Detectives Rose, Stovall and Adams, indicating it was a 303 calibre rifle; it was confiscated, together with a partial box of 303 ammunition.

I am still looking for "Willie Randle."
