Dear Sylvia:

The Citizens Commission of Inquiry (CCI) has just been formed.

Its primary mandate is to secure and analyze all of the evidence including previously suppressed data that reveals the CIA, FBI and other federal police coverup of the facts surrounding the assassination of John F. Kennedy and to make that material available, upon request, to the appropriate investigating committees of the United States Senate and the House of Representatives. Upon request, CCI personnel will also act as liaison with Congressional Committees.

Demands for all of the previously suppressed evidence have already been filed under the new Freedom of Information Act which became effective just a few days ago. In that effort, CCI is working with Morton Halperin, former deputy assistant Secretary of Defense, now director of the Project on Freedom of Information and National Security.

We are bringing together trained personnel who have operated in the past from different disciplines including: former CIA technicians, former Special Agents of the FBI, professors of criminology, pathologists, photo-analysts, physicists, investigators, writers, lawyers, law professors and students.

As the evidence is secured and analyzed, we expect to organize seminars for members of the Congress, representatives of the media and the public.

In addition, we expect to encourage the initiation of special educational television and radio documentary programs and to assist such programs through Commission personnel and data. Similarly, educational material will be prepared for the print media and provided to investigative reporters.

We hope to aid in the establishment of study groups at colleges and universities through lectures and organizational efforts there. Law students and students of contemporary history will be encouraged to arrange for accredited courses at law schools and at other educational institutions.

I am asking you to join with Richard Barnet, Robert Borosage, George O'Toole, Bernard Fensterwald, John Marks, Marcus Raskin and myself and others, some of whom are described above, to serve on the Executive Board of the Commission.

Please return the enclosed response at your earliest convenience so that our important work together may proceed.
