I have asked Senator Schweiker to respond to your question about the identity of the seven critics whose dossiers were requested by the White House, and he has indicated that he is not free to release these names at this time. Of course, it is possible that other names which have not yet been disclosed were subsequently added to the list, but Senator Schweiker has no information to indicate that this occurred.
