Thank you very much for your letter of August 3rd and for your helpful suggestions about approaches to publication of the subject index to the Warren Report/Hearings and Exhibits. I do appreciate your prompt response and thoughtful advice.

Since writing my letter of the 19th I have encountered two more cases of subpens—Revilo Oliver and Curtis LaVerne Crafard.

I have the impression that your interest in the Warren Report centers on the constitutional and legal aspects rather than on the evidence and the crimes as such. However, I hope that you will not hesitate to call on me if the repercussions of the symposium in the NYU Law Review should cause you to examine other aspects of the Report. Prolonged study has compelled me to question the quality of the investigation and the conclusions reached in the Report. You may be interested in an article on the rifle which appears in the current issue of Life Magazine; also, I have heard that the Warren Report is to be discussed on WNEC radio in a five-hour program which begins at midnight, on Friday the 27th of August.
