This thing has been knocking around in my head for awhile and I finally got time to put it on paper. This covers a very limited area -- an area I have been focusing on, as I mentioned in one of our telephone conversations.

This belongs with a lot of other stuff I've yet to write down. Soon as I do, I'll send them along for your comments.

"Eu tu Kellerman!" -- Was reading S.S. Protective Research Chief Robert Bouck (Kellerman delivers the autopsy x-rays and photos to him after the autopsy, so he can protect them, I suppose) and Bouck is recounting the sterling qualities of the Secret Service. He said there was only two people in the trip index file -- only two people in all the cities the President was going to visit in Texas who were considered a danger to the President and one of these people was a nutty lady in Houston. Then he said:

"We have not only studied all of our own but we have studied all of the assassinations that we could find any record of for 2,000 years back. And strangly enough, some of the thinking that went on 2,000 years ago seems to show up in the thinking of assassinations today.

MR. STERN: Do you increase protection on the Ides of March?" (4:304)

What did he say? The ides of March? What was this crack all about? Well, I suppose I'll have to design another poster now showing a sooth-sayer sitting in the corner of Elm and Houston shouting, "Beware the 22nd of November" to JFK as they round the corner.

Haven't had any verbal or written contact with David. Finsterwald saw him when he was here two weeks ago and gained the impression that David was nowhere near completion of his manuscript, and that David was trying to use Bud as a negotiator to get us back together. I spent about 15 minutes telling Bud I was through with David and his idiotic behavior.

Just completed a log of 38 hours of t.v. and radio broacasts on November 22, 23, 24, 25, 26 and 27 and will be happy to send you a copy. Think you will find it interesting and if there is any specific areas you want \mathbf{x} transcripted or put on tape I can do that too. Let me know.
