Thanks so much for your very well reasoned letter of January 13th commentating on my letter to Larry Haapanen. I had never studied Oswald's reading habits and the fact that he (or someone) returned four books on 10/3/63. That does cause some wonder.

Appreciate your thoughts on Medford Evans and agree mostly with what you say about him -- that it is nonsense to suggest a pact between Jim Garrison and RFK. I do feel that J.G. helped RFK politically though -- even if only in an indirect way -- and that the help was <u>very</u> unwelcome.

I know of one case, that I cannot mention, that makes me believe the Kennedy's were actually working against J.G.

I am having difficulty cataloging - making an inventory of the JFK autopsy photo and x-rays. I am trying to determine just how many negatives and transparancies were deposited in the archives. Do you have any sources that can help me? I have news sources **that** and the 1968 Panel Review report but lack the Memorandum of Transfer from the Kennedy family to the Archives dated April 26. 1965.

I have sent to the archives for this but must wait three weeks for a reply. Do you know of any other sources (primary, not secondary) for this material?
