Cyril, please forgine me and tenders tender my situation. Of all the people of the not want to fail, you are at the top of the list. You have been so coverageous all these years as a foremost critic and The one who probably had the most to risk professionally and personally.

I feel certain that your very presence will ensure the success of the program and I am peally heart sick that I cannot be there.
