Dear Mrs. Meagher:

I've enclosed a copy of "THE JFK CONFLICT". Two things need to be explained. First, this is a copy of the show as it is being sent to radio stations around the country. The tape begins with three "promo" announcements, used to publicize the broadcast, before the actual program begins. Secondly, this tape is a high-speed dub made on a commercial grade tape. It will have a bit more noise on it and be of lesser fidelity than the large reel-to-reel tapes that are being provided to the stations airing the program.

Your comments are scattered throughout the program. I believe that you are in the show five or six times.

The program, for which I was responsible only for the initial research and interviews, is a quickly paced overview of the entire case and the controversy and speculation surrounding it. I hope that you are happy with how you come across in the program.

I want to let you know that I have greatly appreciated all the time you've spent with me on the phone. You have certainly been helpful to me.

I've continued to read about the case. I find it terribly distressing, but I'm not quite sure what I am supposed to "do" about it. Certainly there have been other shameful episodes in our nation's history but this -- the unsolved murder of our president -- is particularly disturbing to me.

My hope is that the broadcast of this show will at least arouse some interest in the uninformed. It will be broadcast in New York City on WMCA RADIO on Tuesday, Nov. 22 from 1:00 to 3:00 p.m.

Please let me know if you run across any information that you feel might be useful to Me. I'm very disappointed that I will not be attending Wecht's

symposium next week.
