References made to the "Three Tramps"; the "Billy G. Harper skull fragment"; the mystery of the "Mexican Oswald;" Smith's discovery of a gun coupon which had gone unnoticed on the reverse side of another found among Oswald's things; possible links with Watergate (see p. 4); Patler and the assassination of George Lincoln Rockwell; Garrison's assassination suspicions and the "second Oswald";

This was a devil of a thing to piece together; your friend was none too careful about his cutting, as you will see.
