Dear John,

This is just a hasty note to thank you for your letter of the 5th and the copy of the government's response to your suit. I will read it carefully the moment I can and send you any comments, if I have any thoughts that may be useful.

At the moment, I am over my head with UN work and have had to neglect all my own correspondence. Usually I reply to letters within a day, but this time we have a cholera problem and the 25th anniversary of the UN to cope with.

I was very surprised to learn from your letter that Dr Noguchi did not perform neutron activation analysis on the RFK assassination bullets. If you had misunderstood him, so did others to whom he spoke and who told me categorically that he had conducted such tests and that they had established that all the missiles involved came from the same weapon. In the light of what he has now told you, I wonder if we can still assume that only one weapon was fired.
