The following investigation was conducted as a result of the President's Commission receiving information that former Vice President RICHARD M. NIXON's secretary, ROSEMARY WOODS, had a newspaper article indicating that Mr. NIXON was either going to Dallas or planning to go there in October 1963. Such investigation was conducted in connection with MARIMA OSWALD's claim that she had locked LEE HARVEY OSWALD in a room to prevent him from doing harm to Mr. NIXON when Mr. NIXON was supposedly coming to Dallas in April 1963.

Previous investigation failed to reveal that Mr. NIXON went to Dallas in April 1963, or that he was scheduled to go to Dallas at that time.

Contact with the office of former Vice President RICHARD M. NIXON in New York City on June 19, 1964, revealed that ROSEMARY WOODS did not have the newspaper article in question, but she believed such an article did appear in a Dallas newspaper.
