Dear Sylvia:

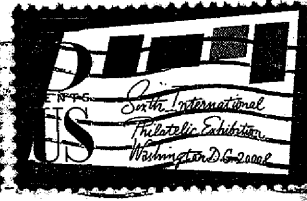
