Mr. H. S. AIKEN, warehouseman-supervisor, Texas School Book Depository, 411 Elm, stated he, AIKEN, maintains the time records on the men employed in the warehouse. He stated he prepared the payroll records that included LEE H. OSWALD during the period October 15, 1963, to November 22, 1963, and knows that OSWALD was carried as LEE H. OSWALD during the period of October 15, 1963, to November 15, 1963, and as LESLIE OSWALD during the period November 16, 1963, to November 22, 1963. He said this was an error on his, AIKEN's, part, in that he merely put down the given name wrong. He said the person referred to in these records as LEE H. OSWALD and as LESLIE OSWALD is one and the same person whose true name, as far as is known to him, AIKEN, is LEE H. OSWALD. Mr. AIKEN pointed out that he, AIKEN, did not know LEE HARVEY OSWALD as they worked in different warehouses and some of the data used in preparing his, AIKEN's, records was furnished to him by phone while other data was furnished in writing and, not knowing OSWALD, he inadvertently recorded the given name wrong.

Mr. AIKEN said he noticed the error in listing OSWALD's first name in his record at the time he furnished the records to SA NAT PINKSTON on November 25, 1963, but decided not to correct the name at that time even though he, AIKEN, knew it was in error. Mr. AIKEN emphasized that LEE H. OSWALD was not known to him, AIKEN, as LESLIE OSWALD and never used that name to his knowledge.
