## Hospital Casts Doubt on a Reported Birth

Richardson, Tex. (AP)--Mrs. Marina Oswald Porter, widow of the man named by the Warren commission as President Kennedy's assassin, reportedly gave birth to her third child yesterday, but officials at Richardson General hospital, located in a Dallas suburb, would neither. confirm nor deny the report.

Mrs. Laura Reeder, hospital administrator, told the Associated Press that "to the best of my knowledge" Mrs. Porter had never been a patient in the hospital.
