Oswald's Widow Bears A Son, Paper Reports

Richardson, Texas, July 5 (AP)—Mrs. Marina Oswald Porter, widow of the man accused by the Warren Commission of assassinating President Kennedy, has given birth to a boy, according to the Dallas Morning News.

Officials at Richardson General Hospital and Mrs. Porter's mother-in-law would neither confirm nor deny the report.

The newspaper said the 6-pound 12-ounce boy was born yesterday and was named Mark Wayne Porter.

Mrs. Porter, 24, married Kenneth J. Porter, 28, a Dallas area electronics firm employee, June 1, 1965, about eighteen months after her first husband, Lee Harvey Oswald, was shot and killed by Dallas night club operator Jack Ruby. She and Oswald had two children, June, 5, and Rachel,
