For background information, enclosed for the Bureau and Newark are Photostats of news clippings from the NY "Herald Tribune", 11/1/58 and the NY "News" of 6/9/62, relative to subject who, in 1959, allegedly applied to be a Soviet citizen, but recently, 1962, apparently changed his mind and is returning to the US.

On 6/12/62, Inspector CARL JOHNSON, INS, NY, advised that on the Advanced Manifest for the ship, "SS Maasdam", Holland-American Lines, there appears the names LEE OSWALD, Mrs. MARINA OSWALD and daughter JUNE. No other identifying information is furnished.

This ship will dock at Holland American Lines, 5th St., Hoboken, at approximately 11:00 AM on 6/13/62. Cutter will leave from Coast Guard Pier, Staten Island, at 9:00 AM.

INS advised that it had correspondence dated 3/23/62, from WILLIAM ABBOTT, Office of the Chief of Naval Personnel, Washington, D.C. INS has notified local DIO, 3rd ND. NY taking no action and this is submitted merely for Bureau and Newark information.
