

Yank Changes Mind; Homing From Russia

— Moscow, June 8 (UPI). — Lee Harvey Oswald, an ex-U. S. marine from Fort Worth, Tex., who came here to live three years ago, declaring he would never return to America, is homeward bound with his wife and child, the U. S. Embassy said today.

Oswald, 23, his Russian wife and their infant child left about 40 days ago.

Oswald came here in October, 1959, shortly after being dis-

charged from the Marine Corps. He told newsmen at that time that he planned to acquire Soviet citizenship and that he would "never return to the United States for any reason." He said he "could not be happy living under capitalism."
