The attention of the Bureau is called to the fact on 6/26/62 subject was very difficult to interview. He was curt and short in many of his answers. He gave the impression of being cold and arrogant and on the whole interview was generally uncooperative.

Near the end of the interview subject was asked whether or'not he would be willing to submit to a Polygraph examination as to answers given by him during the interview of 6/26/62. Subject stated he would not be willing to take a Polygraph test concerning answers given by him during the interview. declined to give any reason for his unwillingness to take a Polygraph test. In this connection, subject was asked whether or not he would take a Polygraph test as to his negative answers to the questions as to whether or not he had furnished any information to the Soviets, as to whether or not he had been recruited by the Soviet Intelligence Agents and whether or not he had made any deals with the Soviets in order to obtain permission to return to the United States.
