Mrs. RUTH PAINE, 2515 West 5th Street, Irving, Texas, furnished the following information:

She has known LEE and MARINA OSWALD since meeting them at a party in February 1963 at the home of EVERETT GLOVER, 4449 Potomac, Dallas, Texas. GLOVER has now moved to 5723 West Southwestern Boulevard in Dallas, telephone FL 2-5296, and she believes he is living in the home formerly occupied by GEORGE DE MORENSHIELDS. She stated that GLOVER had met the OSWALDS through the DE MORENSHIELDS who are now in Haiti where GEORGE DE MORENSHIELDS is employed as a free lance geologist.

Mrs. PAINE stated that the OSWALDS were not separated in the marital sense but their physical separation was occasioned by financial difficulties since OSWALD was not making enough money to support both himself and his wife and since Mrs. PAINE did not invite him to live at her home with his wife.

Mrs. PAINE stated that LEE OSWALD first appeared in Dallas about October 24, 1963 and stated that he had been in Houston looking for work after leaving New Orleans and had been in town a few days before he contacted Mrs. PAINE and MARINA. He did not say anything about being in Mexico if he had been in Mexico prior to that time.
